Dues increase each year to \$25.00 after the first scheduled Fun Show in May. Membership can be submitted in person at either the membership meetings, at any of the RSC shows, or by mailing a check payable to *Redfield Saddle Club* at PO Box 92, Adel, Iowa 50003 along with a completed membership form.

Please Note: In order to qualify for year-end HIGH POINT AWARDS, TALL IN THE SADDLE, or to participate in the QUEEN CONTEST, membership in the Redfield Saddle Club must be submitted and paid before or on the scheduled first Fun Show in May 2010. In addition, those members interested in High Point Awards are required to volunteer 4 hours at any RSC event in the same season to be eligible for these awards.

All Redfield Saddle Club Members are asked to volunteer 4 hours at any RSC event each season. For horse shows, this can include manning gates, assisting judges, show announcer, cook shack, or taking entries.

REDFIELD SADDLE CLUB RULES

The goal of the Redfield Saddle Club is to promote events that are both fun and safe for all involved. All participants in activities at the Redfield Saddle Club Arena must observe the following:

1. Alcohol consumption is not permitted on the Redfield Saddle Club Arena grounds.
2. No Horses around the cook shack.
3. Dogs must be on a leash and should be kept away from the arena.
4. Horses participating in RSC events should be current with vaccinations.
5. Horses should be ridden only at a walk on the grassed areas outside the arena to ensure safety for horses, riders and spectators.
6. Appropriate tack and attire should be considered, but dress is casual. Boots with heels are suggested for safety reasons and helmets are highly encouraged.
7. No entry into a class will be allowed once the gate is closed.
8. Unruly horses may be asked to leave the ring at the judge's discretion.
9. Entry fees should be paid and a show number acquired before entering the class.
10. Judges decision is final. Any complaint against a judge must be addressed to a RSC Board Member. No one should approach the judge without a RSC Board Member present.

For the safety of riders and horses and spectators at our shows and on trail rides, we expect everyone attending will observe these **simple** rules as they continue to enjoy participating in RSC activities.
