

## **Redfield Saddle Club High Point Awards**

Points for Year End Awards will be kept for RSC members only. Must be a member prior to the first show of the season.

RSC members interested in High-Point will be required to work at any RSC sponsored event. Notify an RSC Board member of the show date or event that you would like to work.

Assisted Riders will receive a Participation ribbon at each show. Classes will begin with the adults and end with the youngest riders so the younger riders can learn by watching more experienced riders. Age classification of classes will be:

**35 & Over**

**19 - 34**

**13 - 18**

**9 - 12**

**8 & Under**

In order to qualify for an award, all volunteer hours must be completed by the last show of the season. Points will be awarded in the following classes:

Walk Trot    Western Pleasure    Poles    Barrels

The point schedule is as follows:

<u>Placing</u>	<u>Points Awarded</u>
1 <sup>st</sup>	5
2 <sup>nd</sup>	4
3 <sup>rd</sup>	3
4 <sup>th</sup>	2
5 <sup>th</sup>	1

If an individual enters two horses in poles and/or barrels, only the highest placing will be recorded for that event. (ie: If you run two horses in poles and place 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, only 4 points are awarded.)
