

Barrel Racing

Gates must be closed prior to starting - no running starts.

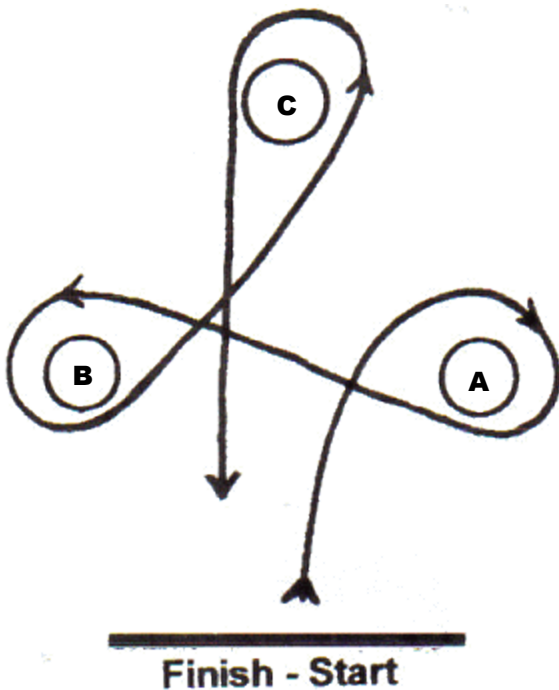
Scoring Procedure:

- A. This is strictly a timed event. The individual with the fastest time is the winner, the second fastest time is second, etc.
- B. A five second penalty will be assessed for each barrel that is knocked over.
- C. Any contestant not following the exact pattern will be disqualified and no points awarded.
- D. Off course is defined as passing by the center of a barrel on the wrong side as far as the shoulder point is considered to be off course. Extra loops in the pattern other than those normally diagrammed should be considered off course.
- E. An exhibitor may be assisted by an adult but no points or placing will be awarded.

BARREL PATTERNS

Typical barrel pattern - shown below

Horse runs with one turn to the right (A) and two turns to the left (B & C).



Other acceptable barrel pattern - shown below

Horse may also run with one turn to the left (B) and two (A & C) turns to the right.
